The initial grant was made on February 24, 2017, but was subject to the satisfaction of performance-based conditions established in connection with this grant. On February 21, 2020, the Company confirmed the satisfaction of the performance-based conditions established in connection with this grant, and the Reporting Person has voting rights and dividend entitlement with respect to these shares, but full ownership will not vest until the satisfaction of additional service-based conditions.

2. These securities were granted pursuant to the Company's 2010 SIP. The Reporting Person has voting rights and dividend entitlement with respect to these shares, but full ownership will not vest until the satisfaction of service-based conditions.

3. These securities were granted pursuant to the Company's 2019 Stock Incentive Plan ("2019 SIP"). The Reporting Person has voting rights and dividend entitlement with respect to these shares, but full ownership will not vest until the satisfaction of service-based conditions.

4. A total of 862 of these shares were acquired through the Company's Employee Stock Purchase Plan in July 2019. Number of shares may vary due to dividend reinvestment.

5. Reporting person disclaims beneficial ownership of securities owned by children who share the Reporting person's household. This report shall not be deemed an admission that the Reporting Person is the beneficial owner of such securities for the purpose of Section 16 or for any other purpose.

6. Based upon information supplied by the plan record keeper as of December 31, 2019. Number of shares varies periodically based on contributions to plan.

7. These securities were granted pursuant to the Company's Performance Stock Plan ("PSP"). Based on the satisfaction of conditions established pursuant to the PSP, the Reporting Person has voting rights and dividend entitlement with respect to these shares based on the satisfaction of certain performance-based criteria, but full ownership will not vest until the satisfaction of additional conditions.
